

## ***Snow Days and Unexpected School Closures***



*Several people have asked the question, “When do you call a snow day?” There are many pieces that come into play when this decision is made. The most important variable is the ability to get students to school safely. In order to determine this, local highway superintendents are consulted along with district snowplow drivers. Weather forecasts are monitored, and superintendents from surrounding school districts are referred to. Decisions are made in the interest of student safety after a thorough review.*

*Sometimes, some parents believe that the roads are too dangerous and question why school is open. If a parent believes that their child/children may be put in a dangerous situation because school wasn't closed, the caretaker has the right to keep the children home for the day.
